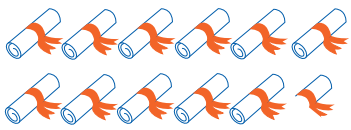
### WE SPEAK A COMMON LANGUAGE: **SERVING THE PUBLIC**

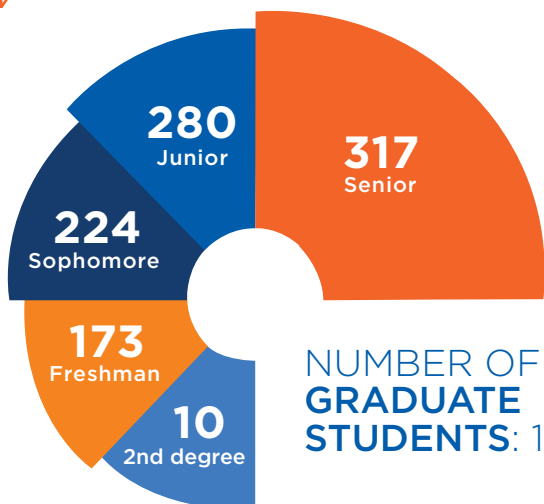

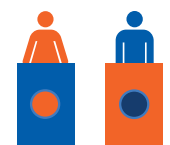
